M. Lawrence G.R. Demi-Sec Leelanau Peninsula, MI. <i>Labeled specifically for Grand Rapids. Vidal and muscat varietals produced with the cuvee closed method</i>	32
M. Lawrence Sex Leelanau Peninsula, MI. <i>Bold fruits intertwine with yeast and delicate bubbles from a blend of pinot noir and chardonnay grapes creating a gorgeous pink hue</i>	9 (draft)
L. Mawby Blanc de Blanc Leelanau Peninsula, MI. <i>Silky and creamy complexity with a citrus zip, twice fermented and created with predominantly chardonnay grapes</i>	50
Domaine Collin Crémant de Limoux Tradition Brut Languedoc-Roussillon, FR. <i>produced in the traditional champenois method with secondary fermentation occurring in the bottle. 50% chardonnay, giving the wine brightness, blended with 40% chenin blanc adding texture & richness followed with 10% pinot noir contributing depth. A true testament to the region that has been producing sparkling wines since the 1500's.</i>	50
R.H. Coutier Grand Cru Blanc de Blancs Brut Ambonnay, France. <i>100% chardonnay aged in stainless steel. apple, white stone fruit and citrus on the nose with a creamy texture and mineral tones round out racy acidity. This wine is the epiphany of what a Grand Cru represents</i>	90

Cantina Colli Euganei Prosecco Spumante Euganean Hills, Italy. <i>Volcanic soil, have a refined minerality & earthiness with hints of fruit & a pleasant, dry mouth feel</i>	9.5/36
Hybrid Pinot Grigio Lodi, CA. <i>Certified organic, this pinot grigio starts with aromas of ripe citrus & mellow fruits and a bright, vibrant finish</i>	8.5/32
Girls in the Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc Lake County, CA. <i>harvested one hour north of Napa Valley, this wine has some mineral fruit with a citrus crispness of freshly cut pineapple that finished light with lemongrass and fig in the background.</i>	9 (draft)
Albert Mann Auxerrois Vieilles Vignes Alsace FR. <i>lively straw-yellow pigments with fresh flowers & a bouquet of fresh flowers & stone fruit complimented by splashes of honey and sweet spices balanced with a drier, more tanic palate finishing with a considerable verve from the minerality.</i>	54
Praxis Viognier Sonoma County, CA. <i>Crisp, dry, & full-bodied with a lingering finish of ripe fruit fermented in stainless steel & seeing no oak. Delicate floral and citrus scents are followed by guava, jasmine and white pear notes with a hint of ginger</i>	52
Villa Wolf Gewürztraminer Pfalz, DE. <i>harvested in southwest germany just north of alsace, france, which is one of the warmer climates in the region with predominantly sandstone soil. stainless steel fermentation give this minerality and rose petal aromas and an exotic spice palate</i>	10/ 38
Vina Robles Roseum Rose Paso Robles, CA. <i>roseum translates to color of the rose in latin as is noticed in the beautiful deep salmon hue derived from 24 hour cold skin soaking that is stylistically close to the dry rose's from southern france. syrah is the principal varietal blended with viognier for the strawberry and caramel nose followed with a rich pomegranate mid-palate and a quenching finish.</i>	9.5/40
Allen Scott Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, NZ. <i>vineyards are sustainably managed in the stony Wairau Valley river flats which produce citrus and nettles with hints of passionfruit on the nose and the traditional, but not over the top, tropical fruit mid-palate with an appealing finish.</i>	48
Gramercy Cellars Viognier Columbia Valley, WA <i>aged in 75% stainless steel and 25% neutral French oak, the wine is held up with bright acidity with honeydew melon, lemon rind and tropical fruit aromas with a crisp and acid driven palate with substantial structure</i>	52

Collovray & Terrier Macon Villages Tradition Chardonnay **11/42**
Burgundy, FR. This particular region within Burgundy is known for its extended sun exposure and limestone hills where these grapes are harvested. Pale gold hue with stone fruit and floral aromas with a tart green apple palate are balanced with resounding minerality.

Nathaniel Rose Marsanne **80**
Traverse City, MI. *considered an ‘orange’ wine due to the fermenting of marsanne on skins all the way to dryness extracting its unique hue. Earthy, floral tones aged 18months in french oak with some viscosity on the mouthfeel.*

Castello Della Sala Barmito del Cervo Chardonnay **12/46**
Orvieto, IT *100% chardonnay grown in soil rich in clay & marine fossils then harvested just over two weeks longer than normal due to a mild climate at the time of harvest. Aged in French oak for 5 months along with partial malolactic fermentation bring a light yellow hue with a bouquet of apples & pineapple followed with vibrant minerality & a long, complex finish.*

Sans Liege ‘Cotes du Coast’ Blend **67**
Central Coast, CA. *54% viognier, 19% roussane, 15% grenache blanc and 12% marsanne, this is a very viscous, full bodied white wine that almost has a waxy texture to it while opening up to a zesty, slightly citrusy palate with a touch of toasted oak*

Chateau de La Font du Loup Chateaneuf du Pape **70**
Rhone, FR. *40% Grenache, 30% Roussane, 20% Clairette and 10% Bourboulenc sustainably farmed by the Melia family who took over the vineyards during WWII. The resulting blend is a unique and robust white wine with layers of complexity starting with fruit then evolving into a full-bodied wine perfect for the Chateaneuf connoisseur or adventurous white wine enthusiast*

Hanzell Sabella Chardonnay **94**
Sonoma, CA. *Aromas of citrus & vanilla combine with notes of clove, toast & wet stone. As this chardonnay has time to breathe, jasmine & honeysuckle come forward with a vibrant, long lasting finish*

RED

Mas de Daumas Moulin de Gassac Guilhem Rouge **8.5/29**
Languedoc – Roussillon, France. *A blend of syrah and grenache with a touch of carignan and mouvedre. With hints of spicy strawberry and rich red berry, this is a delicate wine rounded with smooth tannins*

PSH Malbec **10/38**
Mendoza, Argentina. *A lighter styled malbec, perfect for going into spring and summer, hand-harvested notes of oak, plums, blueberries and citrus where the fruit and juice shine with a light, delicate finish.*

Tenuta Ibidini Nero d’Avola **34**
Sicily, IT *Estate-grown, unoaked 100% Nero d’Avola where the winemaker is committed to sustainable & organic practices. Ripe, small red fruit on the nose are followed with a fresh palate and velvety texture on the finish.*

Girls in the Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon **9 (draft)**
Lake County, CA. *Cassis, currant and dark cherry bouquet lead to a mid-weighted wine where the cassis flows through the palate along with cocoa and some earthiness to give this a rounded experience.*

H. Mynor Zinfandel **42**
Sonoma, Dry Creek Valley, Amador County & Lodi, CA. *aged for 12 months in French oak give way to floral aromatics with a spicy palate and finish with soft tannins balanced with a lingering sweet oaky finish.*

Field Recordings Grotto Red Wine **9 (draft)**
Paso Robles, CA. *30% zinfandel and mouvedre along with 10% tempranillo, petite syrah, syrah and graciano from farms selected for quality then blended and aged 14months in oak yielding a deep ruby hue with herbal spice on the nose and palate with an even, rounded finish.*

Chateau de Chamilly Pinot Noir **56**
Bourgogne, FR. *100% pinot noir hand-harvested from 70 year old vines which produce this elegant, unfiltered wine with dark berry nose with a floral cherry and earthy mid-palate with a touch of spice. Bright minerality finishes out from the clay and limestone terroir.*

Christopher Michael Pinot Noir **11/42**
Willamette & Umpqua Valleys, OR. *sustainably farmed yielding generous fruit with intense concentration of tart cherry & raspberries with a spicy touch of tobacco derived from its 10 month aging in 15% new French oak.*

Loring Wine Company Rosella’s Vineyard Pinot Noir **2009 94**
Santa Lucia Highlands – Monterrey , CA. *single-vineyard pinot noir with ripe & fleshy wild berry, plum and spice that gives this wine a full-bodied feel with firm nuances yet delicate in nature finishing with a touch of minerality and spice.*

Domaine Dupre Morgon Le Griottier 2012	56
Beaujolais , FR. this 100% gamay is round and well-balanced, with a palate of pure red fruits, coffee, and tobacco, complemented by an underlying minerality. It opens with a beautiful bouquet of red and black cherries, dark chocolate and raspberry	
Carchelo C Red Blend	40
Jumilla, SP. <i>Monastrell, tempranillo syrah and cabernet sauvignon varietals are aged in oak for four months. intense aromatics with a velvety round palate with red fruit laced with minerality and a lingering finish.</i>	
Force of Nature Red Blend	11/42
Paso Robles, CA. <i>predominately merlot with cabernet sauvignon, syrah and petit syrah provide a deep red hue with a nose that blooms with red cherry and plum. supple tannins are balanced with acidity and restrained structure with a lingering finish.</i>	
Big Table Farm Pinot Noir 2014	90
Willamette Valley, OR <i>producers of this unfiltered wine have a cult like following, featuring green peppercorn & herb on the nose, with dark red fruit balanced with sweet toasted notes on the finish. Recommended for decanting to bring out the full structure.</i>	
McNabb Cabernet Sauvignon	13-5/52
Mendocino County, CA <i>black cherry & vanilla tobacco on the nose from 11 months aging in French oak are followed with rich & elegant fruit with moderate tannins and a smooth finish from the blending of 19% merlot with the cabernet sauvignon</i>	
Copain Les Voisins Syrah	87
Anderson Valley & Yorkville Highlands, CA. <i>This elegant 2009 syrah had fantastic weather which resulted in natural small clusters that intensified the ripe berries on the nose and palate blended with warm tannins and crisp acidity</i>	
d'Arenberg High Trellis Cabernet Sauvignon	56
McLauren Vale, AUS. <i>harvested from sustainably managed vineyards dating over a century, the core of this wine has cassis, licorice and plum mixed with earth and graphite minerality. balanced and weighted, with lacy tannins on the finish.</i>	
Tenuta di Sesta Poggio di'Arna Toscano Rosso	13/50
Montalcino, IT. <i>the traditional varietal blend of Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Sangiovese comprise this "Super Tuscan." Deep ruby red and vibrant purple hues with some spiciness on the nose with a structured palate and velvety tannins.</i>	
Tooth & Nail The Fiend	68
Paso Robles, CA. <i>Harvested from the Tolliver Ranch, which contains an acidic soil that is unusual for the region, the wine is comprised of primarily malbec blended with cabernet sauvignon. Inky purple hue is surrounded with floral lavender aromas with a lush, bright palate with supple tannins and acidity.</i>	
Château Pérenne Cru Bourgeois	58
Bordeaux, FR. <i>93% merlot and 7% cabernet sauvignon planted in clay and gravel, then sees over a year in new French oak, yielding prune and violet aromas with plum, tobacco and figs mid-palate with a spicy firm tannic finish.</i>	
Hoopla The Mutt Cabernet Sauvignon	62
Napa Valley, CA. <i>98% cabernet sauvignon blended with 2% of merlot for texture and aged 18 months in French oak. Hand-harvested fruit from the Yountville, Oakville & St. Helena regions of Napa Valley create this medium-bodied wine with raspberry and blueberry aromas flowing into a soft, creamy texture and a bright finish. Inspired by the winemakers rescue dogs, Sophie & Maya.</i>	
Tinto Pesquera Tempranillo	74
Ribera del Duero, SP <i>100% tempranillo grown in highly elevated clay and gravel soil accentuating the dark berry fruit on the nose with a spicy lift and a layered minerality that continues on the palate for a full-bodied finish.</i>	
Tres Sabores 2010 ¿Por Què No?	52
Napa Valley, CA. <i>From a small certified organic & family-owned vineyard comes this blend of zinfandel, cabernet sauvignon & petite syrah. Fruit forward with substance & texture, this wine finishes with an earthy & robust character</i>	
Château Gigognan Châteauneuf-du-Pape Clos du Roi 2010	79
Rhône, FR <i>80% grenache & 20% syrah, this wine is grown in the southern Rhône Valley & boasts ripe black raspberries with an array of spices. Fresh, with a peppery finish</i>	
Vina Robles Petite Syrah	64
Paso Robles, CA <i>100% estate grown and hand harvested and aged 20 months in French oak. Deep garnet hue leads into black cherry, mocha and vanilla on the nose & palate finishing with a full-bodied, juicy and meaty tannins</i>	
Roberts & Rogers Cabernet Sauvignon 2012	94
Napa Valley, CA. <i>Traditional, full-bodied California-styled cabernet sauvignon blended with 10% merlot to create a layered depth of bold dark cherry & spiced plums as a result of 15 months of age in French oak barrels and juicy tannins on the finish.</i>
